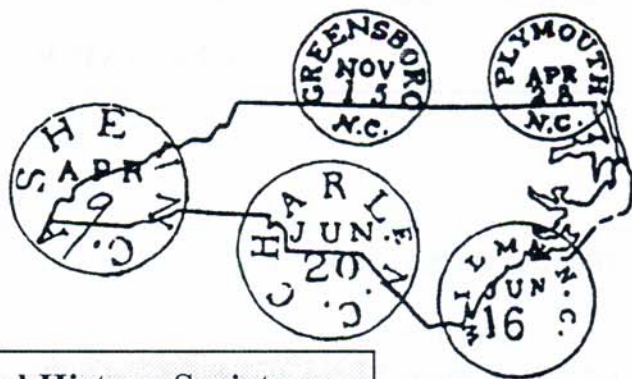

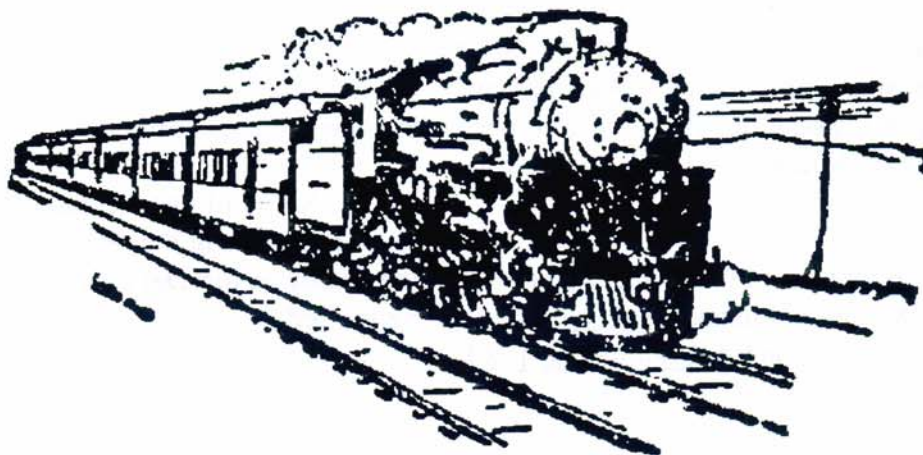

## DELMAR RAY FRAZIER, 1915-1994

The philatelic hobby has seen the passing of one of its most dedicated enthusiasts.

With Tennessee roots that go back to the legendary Daniel Boone, Del Frazier shared a love of history and philately. Few people in the hobby give the commitment of time and energy back to the hobby as did Del over his career as a collector.

Del received his undergraduate degree from the University of Florida, and later achieved a Masters in Economics after retiring from the U.S. Army where he served as a Lt. Colonel. After retirement he became an instructor at Austin Peay State University in Clarksville, TN., and continued work towards his doctorate at the University of Indiana.

Finding an interest in the postal history of Tennessee, in 1985 Del published The Tennessee Post Offices and Postmasters Appointments, 1789-

1984. This work today is considered a must for any Tennessee collector.

After moving to Newbern and later to Raleigh, Del began the research on the Postmasters of North Carolina. This work continued after his move to Charleston, S.C. The research was completed before his death. In recognition of his commitment to the hobby, this research will be published by the North Carolina Postal History Society.

Frazier was an Honorary Life Member of the NCPHS and served our Society as Vice-president and member of the Board of Directors.

Many of us take much from the hobby, but few of us can say they have given back so much to the hobby as did Del Frazier. Del, thanks, you will be missed!
